

## 1. Organizer, place and time

1.1 The competition exhibition in 1st and 2nd place is organized by OK-Gmunden with the support of the Association of Austrian Philatelic Associations and the BMSV-Gmunden.

1.2 The competition exhibition "Alpen-Adria-Philatelie" will take place from 26. to 28. August in the Kongresshaus Toscana, Toscanapark 6, 4810 Gmunden.

## 2. Exhibitor

2.1 The competition exhibition "Alpen-Adria-Philatelie" will be held in 1st and 2nd place. The evaluation takes place according to the exhibition regulations of the VÖPh.

2.2 Exhibitors from all FEPA member countries are eligible to participate.

2.3 All, the show regulations and the Exhibition conditions according to items 4.1 to 8.0 corresponding exhibits can be registered.

2.4 The prerequisite for participation in the exhibition is a corresponding preliminary assessment and the timely registration of the exhibit.

2.5 The presentation of the exhibitor pass is absolutely necessary, when registering the copy of the exhibitor pass must be enclosed with the exhibits.

2.6 The supplementary sheet for the jury must be filled out with the registration.

## 3. Registration

3.3 Show classes with fewer than 5 registrations can be accepted by the exhibition management or will be removed from the competition.

3.4 A philatelic committee is set on the acceptance and number of frames decide. This decision is final.

## 5. Number of frames and fees

5.1 For each exhibit a maximum of 3 - 10m<sup>2</sup> in the senior class and in the youth class a maximum of 2 - 5m<sup>2</sup> frame allocated. 12 sheets of the normal size can be inserted. Two copies are to be sent to the literature class and stay with the organizer.

5.2 The framework fee is EUR 20 per framework, with the exception of youth projects. In the literature class, the fee for one frame is EUR 20.00.

5.3 If the object is dismantled and returned by the exhibition management (in Austria as non-free parcel) must be charged EUR 20 for foreign parcels.

5.4 The fees are due within 3 weeks of receipt of the letter of acceptance to the transfer to OK-Gmunden using the enclosed payment slip.

5.5 The framework fees and return costs of foreign objects are based on the Account OK-Gmunden, IBAN: AT52 2032 0321 0048 6864 free of charge for the organizer transfer.

## 6. Security and Insurance

6.1 The organizer and his agents will do all reasonable and necessary, take measures to ensure the safety and careful handling of the exhibits during to guarantee the duration of the exhibition, but cannot be held responsible for any assume any damage that may occur. The exhibitor places at his own risk and risk off.

6.2 It is recommended that the exhibitors take out appropriate insurance himself.

## 7. Assembly and dismantling of the exhibits

7.1 The exhibits should, if possible, be carried out by the exhibitor or someone commissioned by him, authorized representatives on Thursday, August 25, 2022 from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 5:00 p.m.

7.2 Objects that are to be set up and dismantled by the organizer must be at the latest arrive at the exhibition management on 19 August 2022 free of charge.

7.3 Each sheet must be individually and consecutively numbered (on the back) and be housed in a transparent cover.

7.4 The sheets are placed in the frame from left to right, so horizontally Page sequence, starting at the top left.

7.5 Dismantling will take place on Sunday, August 28, 2022 from 12:15 p.m. after the end of the exhibition and is coordinated by the exhibition management.

## 8. Assessment of the exhibits and awarding of awards

8.1 According to the FIP or VÖPh regulations, the exhibits for all ranks are rated by an international jury.

8.2 The following evaluations will be made for each exhibitor, depending on the exhibition class awarded certificates and medals, certificates in medal rank and only certificates.

The jury and the exhibition management are responsible for awarding honorary prizes.

8.3 The awarding of prizes takes place within the framework of the palmares, which is part of the event program and can be seen.

## 9. Rights of the organizer and the exhibition management

9.1 The decisions of the organizer, the exhibition management, the philatelic committee and the jury are final and incontestable.

9.2 With the registration, these special exhibition conditions are fully recognized in terms of content.

9.3 The applies to disputes that cannot be resolved by the exhibition management the District Court Gmunden is agreed.
